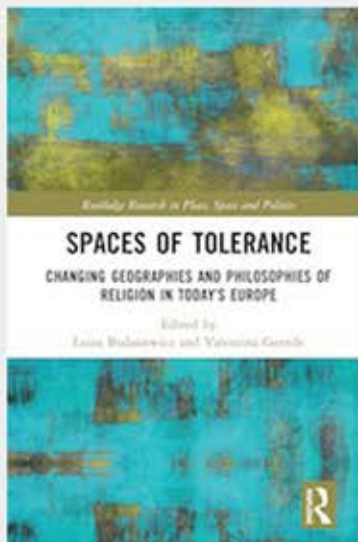

What are the challenges of negotiating religious tolerance in today's Europe? Over the past decade, religion and religious individuals have become increasingly framed as both an internal and external security threat to European states. This edited collection of essays examines the changing politics and geopolitics of religious freedom by looking to how understandings of religious freedom and 'tolerance' touch down in specific places and specific practices across Europe, bringing together theoretical and philosophical reflection with ethnographic analysis of contexts ranging from Belgium, Denmark, France and Italy, to the UK and Turkey. The seminar will present the main findings of the volume and discuss the challenges of conceptualizing questions of tolerance from a multi-disciplinary and multi-sited perspective.
