Rome, *caput mundi*, is the city of cities. No other place in the world has played such an important role in the development of Western culture, from antiquity until today. Rome's history of three millennia is still tangible on every street corner and every square in the city, from the Capitol Hill to St. Peter's and from the classical Forum Romanum to Mussolini's Foro Italico.
